The Way Church of Memphis has been closely monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic as well as the seasonal flu virus and common cold. We want to ensure you, we have taken all the necessary precautions to maintain a safe, healthy and friendly environment for Worship. Some things we are doing to prevent the spread of illness at church are as follow:

- We encourage you to stay home if you're sick. Remember, this is also the cold/flu season. Now, we don't want you to miss out on your worship experience. A live stream will be available on Sundays for the 1 pm service.
- To prevent the possible spread of illness, for now, we are replacing hugs and handshakes with nods and hand over the heart. This will be from the parking lot to the sanctuary.
- We will have disposable face masks for those who become sick at church. The ill individual will be immediately isolated from others and keep on the mask until they leave.
- As of now, we will still have our regularly scheduled service. We will increase ventilation by opening windows or adjusting the temperature in the building. Again, if you're sick, stay home.
- If you are scheduled to serve in ministry and are not feeling well (coughing, sneezing, fever, etc.), please stay home. Your health and safety is our most important concern. Make sure to notify your ministry leader as soon as possible, so someone else can be scheduled to fill in the gap.

- We are not waiting on God but working with God.

In the meantime, please continue to take precautionary measures to ensure your safety. Continue to wash your hand frequently. If you are ill or feel any flu/cold symptoms, please see your doctor or a certified health professional. We will provide additional information as necessary as things continue to unfold.
